CODE OF CONDUCT



This agreement sets the standards for behaviour, discipline, and sportsmanship at Legacy Football Club. Joining our program means committing to a safe, respectful, and high-performance environment on and off the pitch.

Part 1: The Player's Commitment

As a club player, players agree to meet the following expectations:

1. Discipline, Punctuality, and Attendance

- Arrive on time for all training sessions, matches, and team events.
- Notify staff immediately if you are unable to attend due to illness or emergency.
- Wear the correct kit and arrive at sessions prepared.

2. Sportsmanship and Respect

- Show absolute respect to coaches, staff, teammates, opponents, and match officials.
- Accept officials' decisions without arguing, gesturing, or complaining.
- Never engage in bullying, physical violence, or any form of discriminatory abuse.

3. Digital Responsibility

- Use social media responsibly, never posting anything that harms the reputation of the club or others.

Part 2: The Parent / Guardian Commitment

As a parent or guardian, parents/guardians agree to support the child and the club by meeting these expectations:

1. Positive Behaviour

- Encourage all players through positive praise and avoid shouting criticisms.
- Never coach from the side or confuse players with tactical instructions during training sessions and matches.
- Respect match officials and accept that their decisions are final.

2. Operational Support

- Ensure your child arrives on time with the correct kit and equipment.

- Communicate openly with staff regarding injuries, illness, or well-being concerns.
- Pay all fees on time according to the agreed schedule.

3. Safeguarding and Environment

- Support a safe environment free from pressure, abuse, and unrealistic expectations.
- Address any grievances privately with club management, never in front of players or online.

Part 3: Breaches of the Agreement

Failure to comply with this Code of Conduct may result in disciplinary action. Depending on the severity of the breach, actions may include:

1. Verbal or written warnings from club management.
2. Temporary suspension from training and match selection.
3. Permanent termination of the player's registration.
